

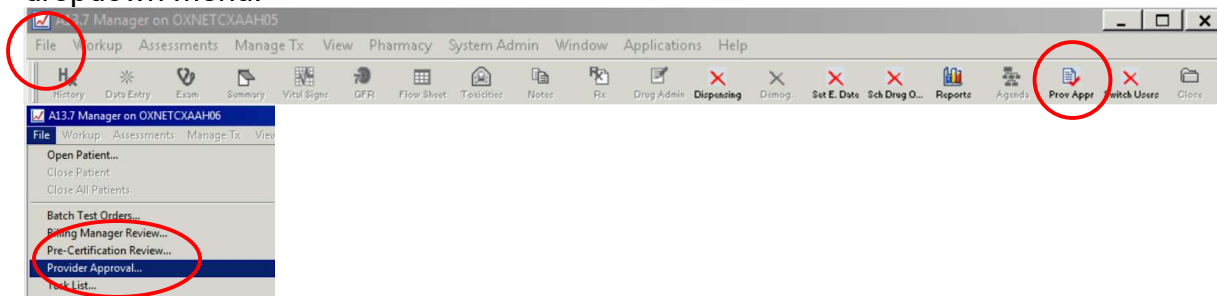

Provider approval

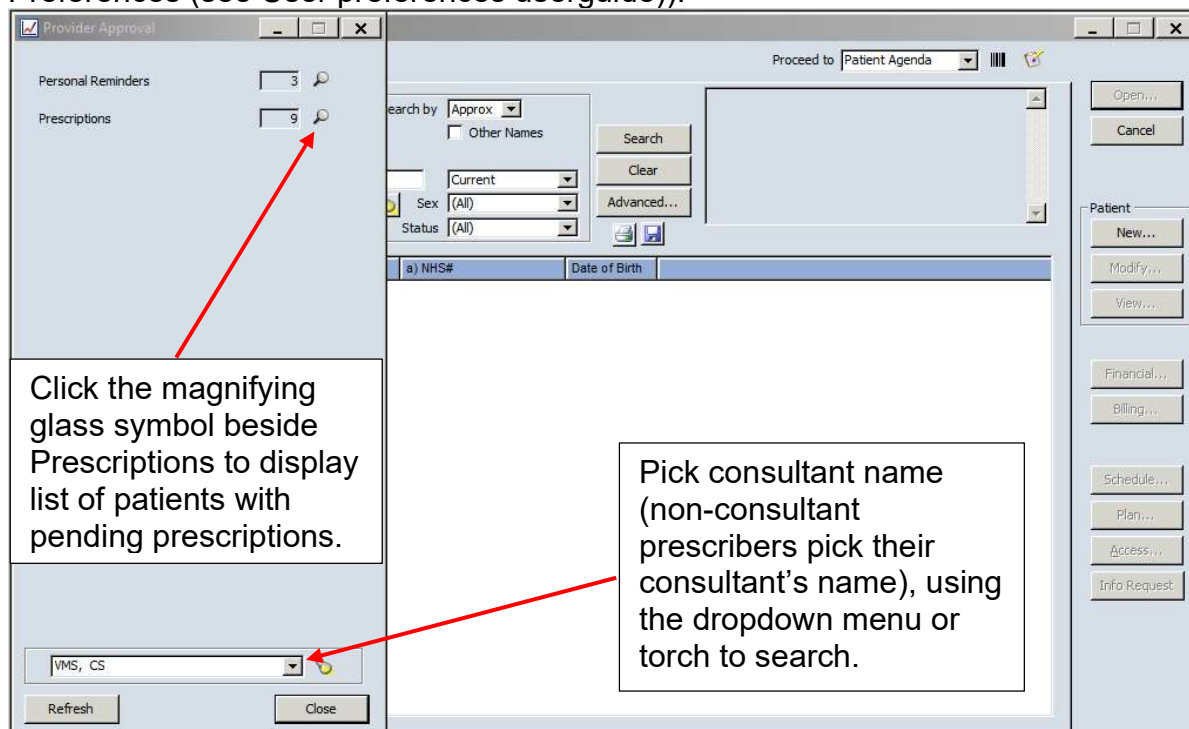
Finding and approving pending prescriptions

Prescriptions which are in pending show as Prescriptions in the Provider Approval box (all pending prescriptions are visible).

To open Provider approval, either click on Prov Appr icon or File then Provider Approval from the dropdown menu.



Ensure only Personal Reminders and Prescriptions are shown. (If not amend settings in User Preferences (see User preferences userguide)).

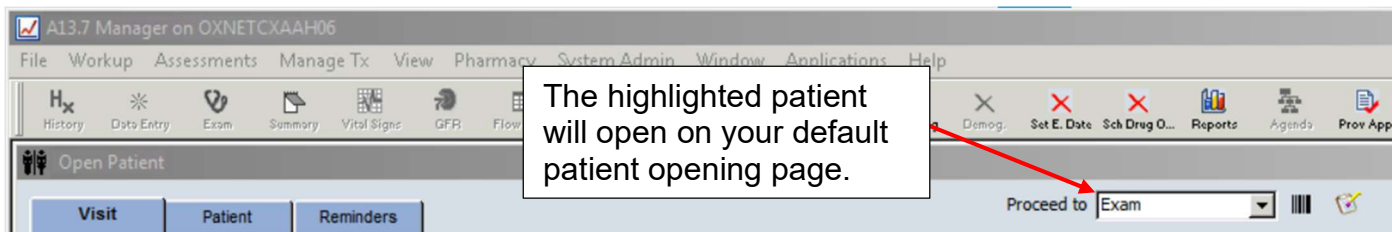

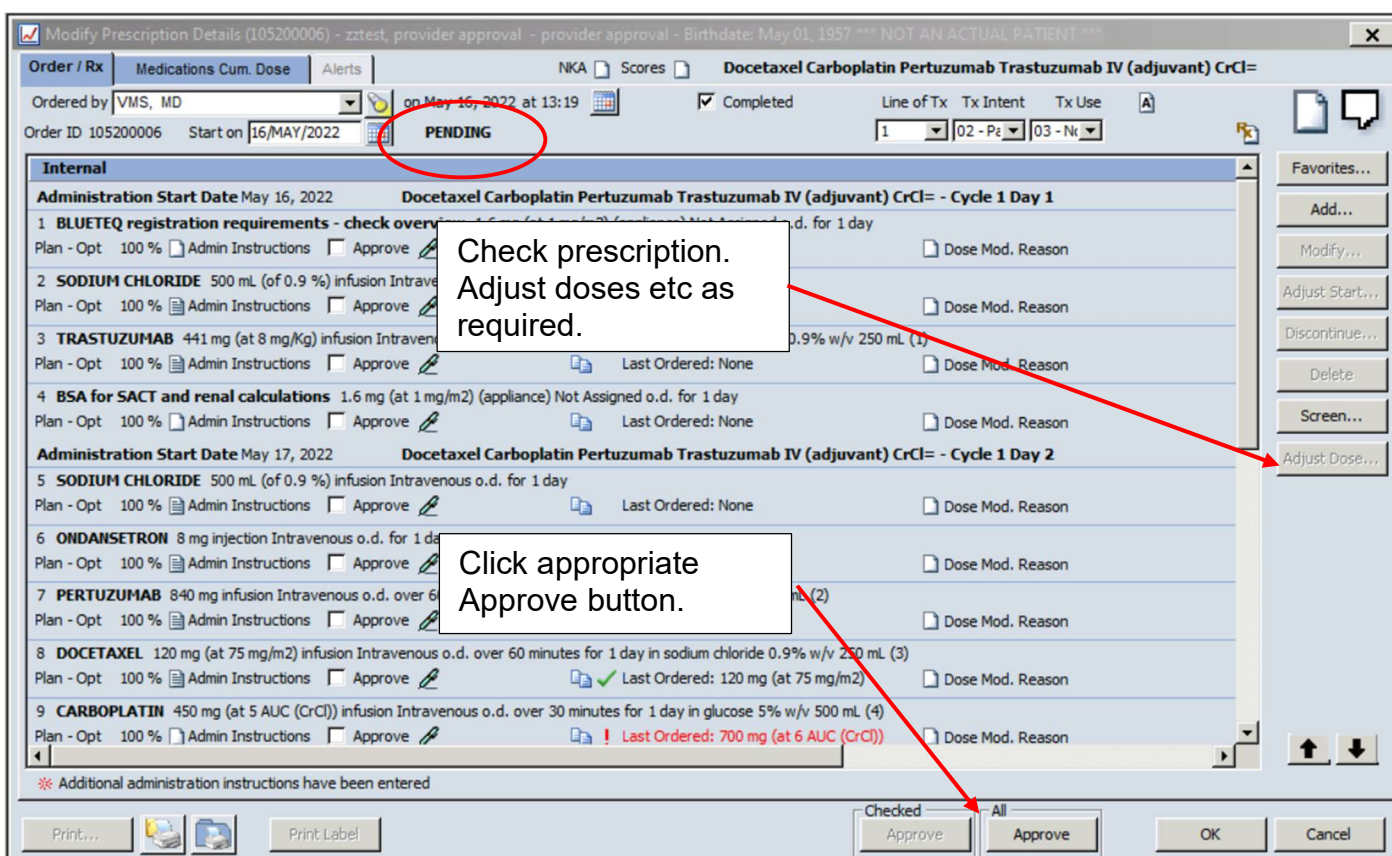
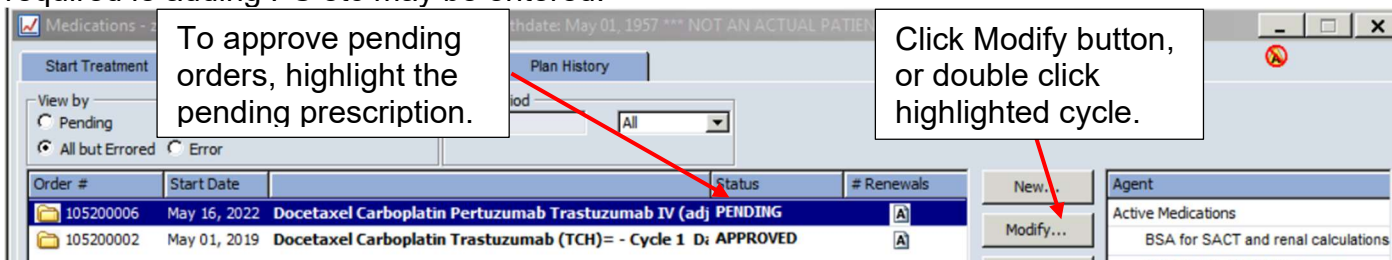

The list can be sorted by patient name, ordered date, start date, regimen etc by clicking on the appropriate header.

Click to highlight the patient you wish to approve the prescription for. Click the folder icon.



Once the patient is open, in addition to approving the pending prescription, everything else required ie adding PS etc may be entered.



When prescription approval is completed close the patient. Aria will automatically return to the Provider Approval pending prescription list.
Work down the list of prescriptions in pending, waiting for approval.

Putting prescriptions into pending

Either the nurse, each time they administer a cycle, or the pharmacist, when they dispense a cycle, needs to put the next cycle into pending.
