

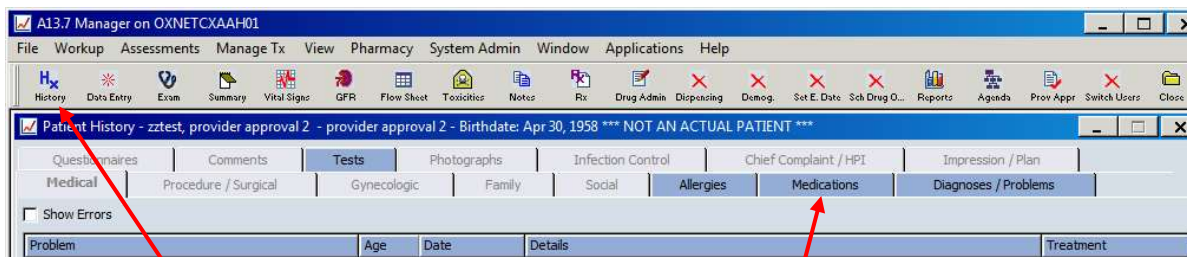
Aria e-prescribing guide

Interaction checking

All medication, SACT and non-SACT, prescribed on Aria will automatically be included in the interaction checking, and does not need to be added.

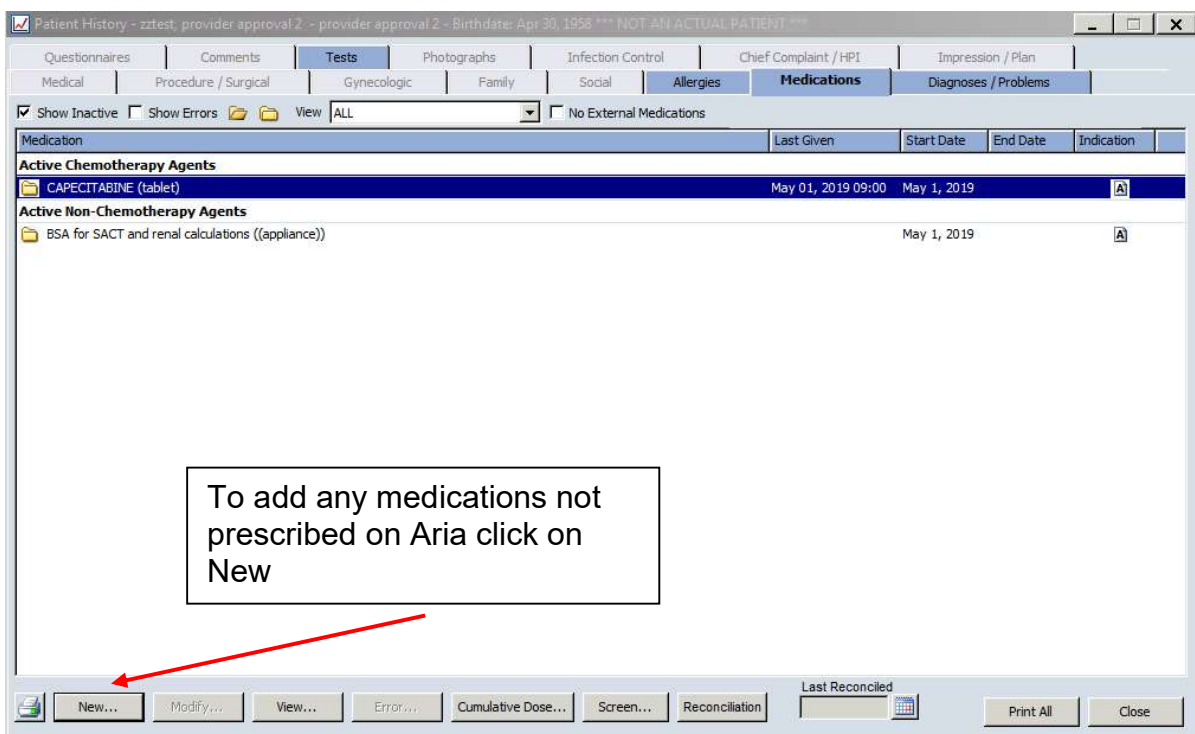
To add other medication, not prescribed on Aria, that the patient is taking to Aria, for full interaction checking.

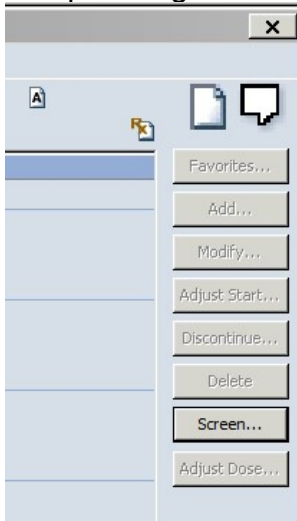
