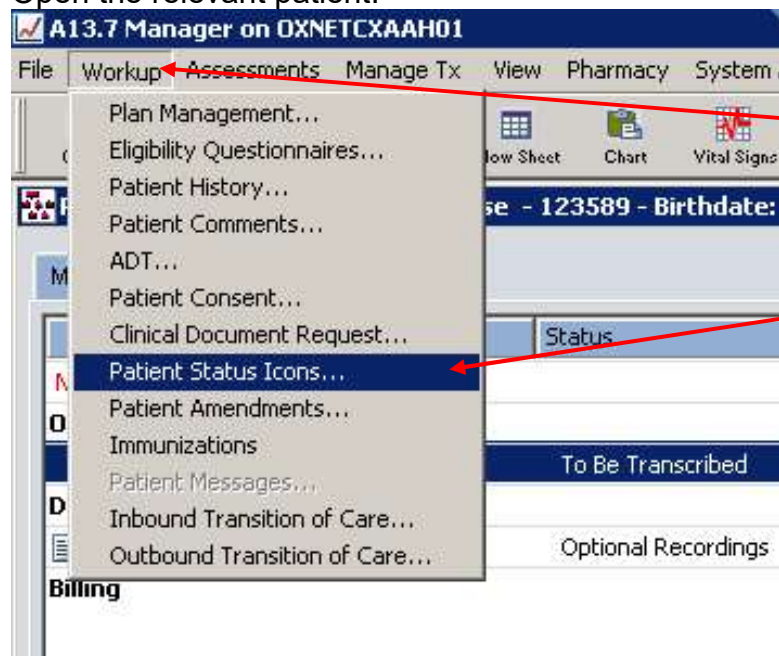

Patient status icons

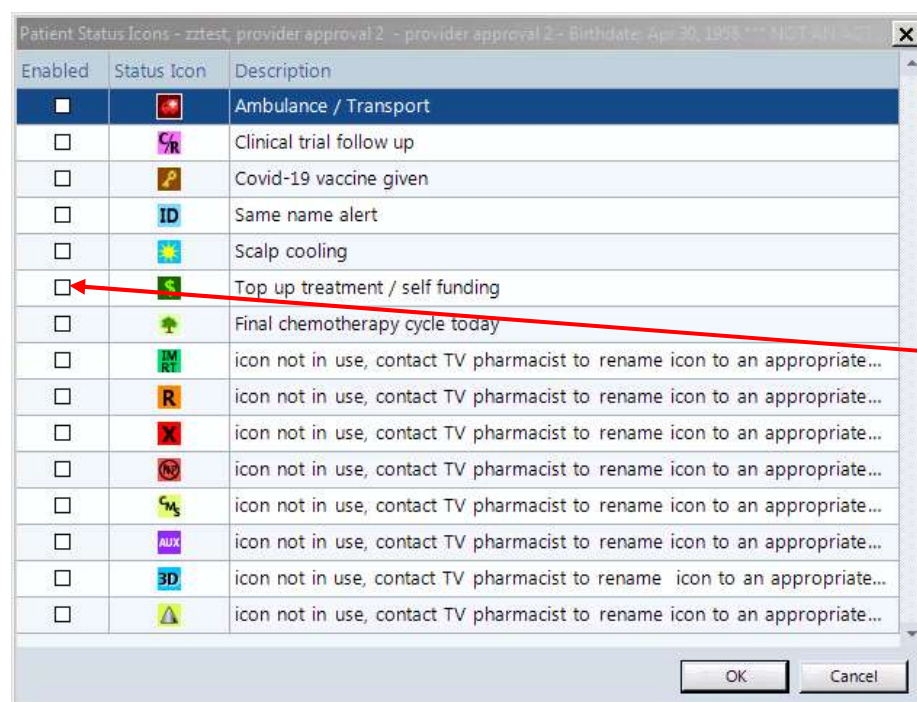
Adding Patient Status Icons

Open the relevant patient.



Click on Workup.

Click on Patient Status Icons



Tick all the relevant named Patient Status Icons required for that patient.
Then click OK.

The allocated patient status icons will be visible on the open patient page, and throughout the patient, once open.

Removing Patient Status Icons

Patient status icons remain visible on the patient until removed.

To remove an icon from a patient follow the same instructions as for adding patient status icons, but untick any icons which are no longer required.
